2010-2011 SCHOOL FEE / REGISTRATION

Registration for the 2010-2011 school year has begun. Current parents are given first priority for enrollment until February 15th. On February 15th, enrollment opens up to new families. After February 15th, we cannot guarantee seats for current students. We anticipate a waiting list in 5K and 7th grade for next year, so current parents are strongly encouraged to register prior to February 15th. If you have any questions, please contact the school office.

Also, the Board of Christian Day School (BCDS) has approved the school fees and tuition for the 2010-2011 school year. As in previous years, the registration fee and tuition have risen approximately 3% to keep in line with increases in costs. The BCDS has also instituted a Building Fee for the 2010-2011 school year to help offset the cost of heating, electricity, and the like. The building fee has been set at \$150 per student. The tuition / fees are as follows:
