#### RE-CHARGE SUMMER SERIES SET AT MT OLIVE

Join other school and church families, visitors and neighbors as we come together on Wednesday evening in worship and fellowship at Mt Olive through our summer series called Re-Charge.

The purpose of the service is directly related to the aspect of allowing God to be the one that "recharges us" and what a better day to do this than one in the middle of the week. The sermon series will use the gospel reading from each week and focus on how God recharges us through what he provides for us. Topics will include things such as : June 16: We are recharged by God when He forgives us and we forgive others, June 30: We are recharged by God when He helps us to set priorities in how we live , July 14: We are recharged by God when He sends us someone in need. In keeping with Re-Charge theme, the service is not a replacement for the regular weekend services, but offers more time for us to learn and grow in God's word and what He offers us in relationship with Him.

The services will have a variety of different music styles to include gospel, jazz, traditional and contemporary. Technology and

other forms of media will encompass the service, including drama, video and other means to get God's word to be proclaimed. Our focus will continue to be on what Mt. Olive has done excellently for the past 100 plus years and that is a focus on the gospel of Jesus Christ as the means of salvation and allowing Him to work through us as His children.

The services will begin on June 16 and will run for the next 8 weeks, ending on August 11<sup>th</sup>. Service times will be at 6:30 p.m. followed by a time of fellowship in the Mt. Olive Courtyard. Further information is available on our website at:
