Midweek Lenten Sermon Series

Lent is the journey we make as we travel with Christ from the Mount of Transfiguration to Jerusalem. This year we focus upon that journey, though perhaps not in the way we usually walk it. Our return from exile brings us into the promised land, the perfect place, the new garden, the courts of heaven—the ultimate destination which was established for us by Jesus' death and resurrection. We contemplate the reality of our earthly journey, but with eyes always fixed on its destination—the empty tomb and the open gates of everlasting life—and with an underlying reality of joy as we hear proclaimed again that we do not walk alone!
